## BROM (Bronze Register of Merit)

To be eligible for the Bronze Register of Merit a dog must have four titles from at least three areas of competition.

## SROM (Silver Register of Merit)

To be eligible for the Silver Register of Merit, a dog must have five titles from at least three areas of competition. One of these must be a either a PWDCA title, or an award.

## **GROM (Gold Register of Merit)**

To be eligible for the Gold Register of Merit, a dog must have earned at least six titles/awards from at least three different areas of competition. Two of the dog's titles must be PWDCA titles (e.g., AWD and WWD). The dog must have earned an award, or have earned a title from a fourth area of competition. A minimum of two advanced titles are required (the WWD counts as one of these). Finally, there must be either an additional advanced title, an award, or an advanced PWDCA title.

### Register of Merit Application Checklist

1. Fill out Dog's Registered name as you want it printed on the ROM certificate, listing ONLY titles which qualify for the award.
2. Send supporting documentation for all titles and awards. AKC reports, or copies of the highest level title certificate for each area of competition are acceptable.
3. Update H&L database annually- if there are no changes, check the box for no changes. Do not send copies of health certificates with this application.
4. Send a photograph of your dog for the awards presentation at the Specialty. Email is preferred.
5. You should receive an email confirmation that your application has been received- if you do not receive an email confirmation contact Leslie Arner to check on it.
